

NIH Training

The training modules offered by NIH will be used to provide a brief overview for ethical treatment of participants in research. These modules focus primarily on medical research, but the reasoning and rules apply to non-medical research as well.

NIH training will account for 30% of your Test 1 grade. An NIH certificate must be attached in the appropriate course dropbox to receive credit. Due date is the same as the due date for Test 1. Credit is awarded on a pass/fail basis. If the your certificate is provided by the due date, then the full 30% will be awarded; if the certificate is not provided by the due date, then the 30% will be counted as 0 for a loss of 30% of Test 1.

- You may proceed to other modules before successfully passing the quiz of an earlier module; you don’t have to complete the modules in the order provided.

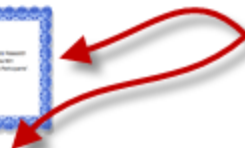
D. Obtain Certificate
